## beer club

The **good**microbrew beer club is designed to reward our regular customers, and say thank you for your continued support. It works much the same as a frequent flyer program.

Use your beer club card every time you purchase a Schooner, or specialty glass of your favorite beer, and you will be awarded points. These points accumulate and you can apply them to the purchase of "**good merchandise**".

You also can use your beer club points to purchase a **good** gift card or use your points to get a discount on food.

- **Point Program:**

- Happy Hour, 1 point per \$1 spent on beer
- Regular priced bottles and drafts - 2 points per \$1 spent
- House Drafts - 3 points per \$1 spent
- Mystery Beer Night 1 point per \$3.00 spent on beer (3 Mystery Beers Limit 3 points)

- **Prize Levels:**

- 100 reward points - **good** Beer Pint Glass (*special club member edition*)
- 120 reward points - \$10 **good** gift card
- 150 reward points - Hat and Tee-shirt
- 250 reward points - \$20 **good** gift card
- 500 reward points - \$50 **good** gift card
- 1000 reward points Coming Soon??

- **Club Rules**

- You **MUST** be at least 21 years of age to join.
- Membership is non-transferable.
- *All points, rules and prize levels are subject to change!*
- Valid photo ID is required to join, as well as to "check out" your card during visits to **good**.
- You must have your membership card to receive credit. No retroactive credits are available.
- If sharing a check please indicate to the server who drank what beers.
- Beer sharing does not count.
- No more than three beers from the **good** microbrew beer club may be consumed at any one sitting. **good** microbrew does NOT wish to promote excessive drinking, but rather beer education and information. All beers consumed over this amount will NOT be counted towards completion requirements.
- **good** beer club" members in training" are responsible for their beer card when it is in their possession. Loss of the card may terminate your membership and result in previously consumed beers not being counted toward **good** beer club completion requirements.
- **good** microbrew reserves the right to refuse the consumption of alcoholic beverages as we deem fit under the guidelines set in place by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board and the State of California.
